One of the city's — and state's — most acclaimed chefs is a two-time James Beard Award winner (most recently crowned Outstanding Chef in the U.S. in 2019) and the owner of six Raleigh restaurants, including Death & Taxes, Beasley's Chicken + Honey, Chuck's Burgers, and Fox Liquor Bar. But Christensen's best-known venture is her first: Poole's Diner. Inside the former 1940s pie shop, diners sit in bright red booths and order from an ever-changing chalkboard menu full of delicious seasonal dishes. Just don't skip the macaroni au gratin.
